Visiting Faculty Position - Transportation

The Lafayette College Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering invites applications for a visiting faculty position that will be filled for the 2012-2013 academic year. We seek applicants with expertise in transportation. Primary teaching responsibility will include an introductory transportation class with a laboratory. Other teaching responsibilities may include an upper level transportation elective as well as introductory engineering courses. Consideration will be given to applicants with an earned Masters degree, but preference will be given to applicants with an earned Ph.D. in civil engineering or a closely aligned field. Excellent communication skills are expected. An individual with industry experience and professional licensure is desirable.

This opportunity provides a teaching experience in one of the nation's few undergraduate-only institutions offering an ABET accredited BS Civil Engineering degree. Lafayette College is an independent, coeducational, residential, undergraduate institution with 2,400 full-time students of high intellectual promise and diverse backgrounds.
