The Tagliatela College of Engineering at the University of New Haven invites applications for a tenure track assistant professor position in the areas of sustainability and energy. Strong candidates with appropriate experience will be considered for appointment at the associate professor level. The expected starting date is August 27, 2012. The successful candidate will lead the college in developing expertise, programs and recognition in sustainability and energy. The academic home of the successful candidate will depend on his or her credentials and background, and a dual appointment is also possible.

Responsibilities include excellent classroom teaching at both the undergraduate and graduate levels, with a special commitment to laboratory and project-based instruction; coordinating the BS program in Sustainability Studies; teaching in the college's Multidisciplinary Engineering Foundation Spiral Curriculum (MEFSC); pursuing funded research; advising graduate and undergraduate student research; pursuing industry/client sponsored projects for students; and participating in course/program development and service to the department, college and the university.

Required qualifications: Ph.D. in engineering or closely related fields with training and work experience in sustainability and energy; strong communications and interpersonal skills; and commitment to collegiality and teamwork. Documentation on authorization to work in the U.S. is also required.

All information on candidates will be kept confidential. Review of applications will start January 16, 2012 and will continue until the position is filled. Qualified candidates should submit a cover letter with a description of their academic and/or industry experiences relevant to the position, curriculum vitae, up to two-page statements of research and teaching interests and contact information for at least three professional references to:
